VOTING IN VIENNA

During the EJTA AGM 2023 we will propose some agenda items which need to be voted on.

Voting will be organised according to our statutes, Article VII, section 1, e:

“All resolutions of the General Meeting shall be passed by an absolute majority of the members in good standing present or represented by proxy. Blank ballots shall be considered not cast. No member shall hold more than two proxy votes.”

So if you can't be present, make sure you appoint another EJTA member to represent you during votes and be your proxy.

ELECTIONS

EJTA President Eric Nahon has been in function for twice two years and is willing to serve you all for two more years on the EJTA Board. That is why we suggest a re-election for him.

Of course, if members want to step up for the position of President in the Board, they are kindly invited to announce this by mail to EJTA Director Nadia Vissers: director@ejta.eu BEFORE 13 October.

We will organise a vote in Vienna according to our statutes.

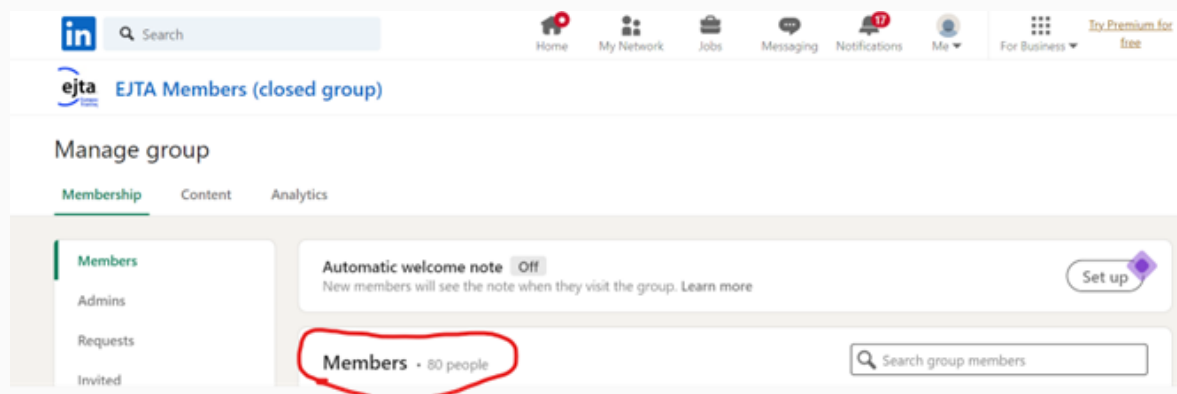
