
MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

PROJECT INCLUSIVE JOURNALISM

EJTA starts with a **new international project on inclusive journalism, funded by the Evens Foundation**. To make this more concrete, here are the following steps:

- 1) **Questionnaire** on inclusive journalism in your curriculum: was sent to you on 17 May. Please make sure you and/or your colleagues fill it by Monday 6 June.
- 2) **Presentation** used in Aarhus, with general intro and info: on the EJTA website.
- 3) **Kick-off meeting in Poznan**, Poland: on 7-8 November 2022, an invitation will be sent to you by middle June.
- 4) Final long-term goal: **creation of a module / project** on teaching inclusive journalism.
