VOTING IN VIENNA

During the EJTA AGM 2023 we will propose some agenda items which need to be voted on.

Voting will be organised according to our statutes, Article VII, section 1, e: "All resolutions of the General Meeting shall be passed by an absolute majority of the members in good standing present or represented by proxy. Blank ballots shall be considered not cast. No member shall hold more than two proxy votes."

So if you can't be present, make sure you appoint another EJTA member to represent you during votes and be your proxy.

EJTAIk 11: 1 DECEMBER 12:00 CET

The next EJTAlk, number 11, will be organised together with the Ethical Journalism Network (EJN) on Ukraine Media: Defiance and Truth-telling.

The EJN launched a report, exploring the state of journalism in Ukraine and the impact of the war on an already challenging contemporary media landscape. The report – titled 'Ukraine media: defiance and truth-telling' – is the final in the Building Trust in Journalism series, looking at the challenges facing media in different countries across Central-Eastern Europe. We do hope also our Ukrainian EJTA colleagues will join as active participants and we invite you all very warmly to participate. Invitation and link will be sent out in November 2023.
