CALL FOR THE TARTU DECLARATION REVISION TEAM

The Tartu Declaration, 50 core competencies that all EJTA members collectively commit to, is our back bone. It serves as a roadmap for the future of journalism, and outwardly reflects our values and goals. These competencies have been revised twice, in 2013 and 2020, and now it's time to begin the next revision process.

We are looking for a dedicated team to prepare this task. The team's work will start at the

beginning of 2025 and the revised Tartu Declaration will be brought forward for joint discussion at the Annual Meeting in October 2026. In fact, we plan for the revised Declaration to be a central theme of our event that year (preliminary information: our intention is to meet in Tartu). The team will meet in person during EJTA events (May 2025, October 2025 and May 2026) and hold additional online meetings as needed. Carien Touwen and Anne Leppäjärvi will lead the team's efforts.

The team will be assembled to ensure versatility in terms of regional representation, experience and expertise.
