Doing Good Interviews: The Who, Why and How of Interviewing Torture Survivors

Torture is a form of censorship, and always a contest over truth. Journalists play a crucial role in supporting survivors to speak out and break the silence. Yet very few media professionals have any knowledge of, let alone training in, the internationally agreed best practices for interviewing torture survivors. Hugh Macleod, a former Middle East correspondent retrained as a barrister and now working at Communications Lead at the International Rehabilitation Council for Torture Victims (IRCT) will present what those teaching journalism need to know about those whose stories are central to the struggle for human rights.
